


Changes to the Girl Form – these are the only forms that will be accepted for the 2012 membership year which begins October 1, 2011.

Information has been reorganized to help to make data entry easier.

1. Girl information – Email – give the email address for girls 13 and up. Parent/Guardian must supply for girls younger than 13. Emails are one of the forms of communication that we will use in the future for mailings.
2. Demographics – now lists why racial/ethnic information is needed by Girl Scout Councils.
3. Parent/Guardian 1 and 2 – If address is same as the girl, put a check in the circle at the beginning of these two sections and make sure to complete the rest of the section.
4. Parent/Guardian 1 and 2 - If address is not the same as the girl (as mentioned above) please make sure to complete this section including address.
5. Permission – If the girl is NOT TO BE photographed, videotaped or electronically imaged, put a check mark in the circle.
6. On the right side the Pathways are listed and defined. Girls have the opportunity to tell us where their specific interests lie.
7. At the bottom right hand side of the form is a section that says pathway of entry. This is to be filled out by the volunteer or staff person completing the paperwork. Check off which pathway the girl has chosen to participate in as she enters the organization. Check only one.
8. Payment – Please remember that GSCSA **does not accept American Express.**

1. In the section called SU/Team Area is the same information as Registration Area (ex. 608,622,430). This section would be completed if not serving in a troop role but service unit role (ex. Service unit manager only).
2. Involve – Check only one for the membership year. If girls are participating only in camp or series pathways they should only mark Individual.
3. Grade Level – Mark one level only based on the majority of girls based on your initial registration. This will be your level throughout the membership year.
4. Annual Registration – The part on the left which states “Total amount of dues” is the total without financial assistance. The part that states “other monies” is where the total for financial assistance should be listed.
5. Payment – the financial assistance should be listed in the line marked other. Please remember that GSCSA **does not accept American Express.**
6. A Membership Dues Summary must be completed **each** time registrations are turned into the Council Service Centers.
